“RESTORATIVE ACTION PROGRAM” SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2017

Community Justice Initiatives Association (CJI) is pleased to be able to award a scholarship to two Langley Grade 12 students involved in Restorative Action in their school. To receive this award, students must meet the scholarship criteria and complete the application guidelines as outlined below.

Scholarship Criteria

To be eligible for the Restorative Action Program Scholarship, you must:

1. Be a Grade 12 student in the Langley School District.
2. Be applying for post-secondary education.
3. Have been trained as a mediator in Restorative Action through the *Conversation Peace* curriculum.

How to apply

1. Fill out the form on the next page and submit it to Saskia Epp at CJI at the address above or by email at saskiaepp@cjibc.org by **Friday, May 26, 2017**.
2. Your application must be accompanied by an essay you have written (250-300 words) on how you have seen Restorative Action benefit your school community and your own life personally.
3. Your application must also be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from an adult on your Restorative Action team.

Special preference will be given to students who show an interest in pursuing peacemaking and/or careers related to Restorative Justice. Final decisions regarding the recipient of the award will be determined by staff from Community Justice Initiatives and the Langley School District.
